Disorderly behaviour in Cygnet

Visit from local Senior Constable Justin Caswell: this special invitation was to discuss the disorderly behaviour we experience in Cygnet, and how best the community can support the youth so they don't end up in the judiciary system. There was a good discussion (with reps from Cygnet Cares and Port Cygnet Scouts) and various aspects were discussed.

- Overall, Cygnet is relatively quiet and typical of country towns.
- tCA will push HVC to increase lighting in public places and install security cameras where needed most.
- A skateboards/bicycles 'bank' will be explored.
- Justin emphasised the importance of locking up houses, sheds and vehicles as an important deterrent.
- Safety on roads was also discussed.
