### **SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER MEETINGS**

# 14/11/2023 Special Meeting with HVC Acting General Manager Lachlan Kranz

These points were discussed:

### • Update on State Gvt grant for new road

It has now been confirmed that the promised new road behind the Mary Street shops is no longer being considered. The reasons given include insufficient funding, impracticality, would not achieve desired outcomes. Council is discussing with State Growth and the Sate Government how to use this money (\$5m) to improve safety on Mary Street (suggestions: lower speed limit, pedestrian crossings, improving carpark behind Town Hall and bus shelter, etc). tCA is working with council on this.

### • Security in parks and dark places

Council is intending to put money in next year budget to buy 'smart' special cameras that would be linked, and report in real time, to different agencies (police, fire brigade, etc) as needed.

### Weighbridge Cottage

Lease will go out for expression of interest. It can be used for displays and storage.

### • Cygnet playgrounds

- o Burtons Reserve: playground equipment will be replaced this year.
- Primary School soccer ground: the easiest solution to provide toilets is to give access to school or sports center.

### Roads and traffic

- Council is getting a ground-penetrating radar to see what's underneath some of the roads, so they can fix them appropriately.
- o Council is applying for a Black Spot funding for Lymington Road; there will be a safety review

### • FOGO (Food Organics Garden Organics) recycling in Cygnet

Council is looking at introducing this. Meanwhile, tCA is looking at doing a pilot program with restaurants and schools to see how this would go.

### • New subdivision Channel Highway to the Esplanade

The cherry trees are on private land and developer intends to remove them.
