SUMMARY OF FEBRUARY MEETING

06/02/2024 Committee Meeting

- **Mary Street safety / New Street**

tCA now has developed a plan for a one-way circuit around the town centre, based on previous public consultations and discussions, that will be presented and discussed with HVC. The plan was discussed further and endorsed unanimously and we are now hoping the project will move forward.

- **Booklet of walks**

The booklet of walks around Cygnet is already starting to be used by locals and visitors! It is available at the Museum and at the Hub, and at the Cygnet market.

- **Park Run**

Discussion on organising a Park Run in Cygnet.

- **Emergency services around Cygnet**

tCA is intending to look at this in further details in the new year.

- **Petition to widen Lymington Road between the roundabout and the cannery**

A letter from the Premier Jeremy Rockcliff was received, saying this is not a priority for State Roads and it won't be done anytime soon.

- **Re-verging the Huon Valley**

A petition is being started to get council to allow residents to plant on the verges they are responsible for. At the moment, only grass is allowed, but plantings of native shrubs could attract birds and bees, and improve the look of our valley.

- **New street banners**

More discussion on getting our school kids to create new designs for the street banners. More on this later.

- **French Day**

The idea of a French Day based on the French Festival of few years back is being discussed.

- **Beautifying Cygnet**

The Huon Valley Garden Club has a project of beautifying the valley. They want to identify spots around our towns where trees and plants could be planted, and council will do the work.

- **Weighbridge Cottage**

The Cygnet Living History Museum had their submission accepted and will have a lease for one year. It can only be used only for storage to start with. The museum is happy to share the space with tCA in exchange for a donation.

- **Old Cygnet Council depot**

There is talk that something would be done with it. More on this later.

- **'Sunrise Breakfast' in Cygnet**

Coming to Cygnet on 28th Feb. This will be an opportunity to showcase our area.
