Improving Healthcare in the Huon Valley

After Rebecca White (Labor) announced Labor were committed to improve healthcare in the Huon Valley, we invited her to come to our meeting to discuss this. She couldn't come, but Toby Thorpe (Labor candidate) came. Labor is committed to improve regional healthcare and improve Esperance Multi Purpose Health Center. Toby told us that they had been meeting with many of the local health providers to understand where the problems are and how it can be improved. There will be a more formal announcement soon.

(Toby also told us that Labor is committed to work with council to get the best for Mary Street safety.)

Mary Street safety

- tCA suggested plans for a one-way system (Mary street and new road behind shops) was on the front page of the Classifieds and on FB. This created quite a lot of comments (some very supportive, some very much against it).
- An email was sent to all the candidates of the current election campaign asking them, if they get elected, will they support this funding commitment during the next term of government. Replies from about half of them so far, all positive.
- We think it is important Cygnet develops around the centre, rather than lengthways (which would increase usage of cars), so we need to keep pushing for a back street.
